Visual	Sound
 <p>1. Yogi(with or without turban) with legs in lotus position, sitting in front on huge gong on purple pillow. His face is serene.</p>	<p>Gong! If you can get a good sound add a chanting: OMMMMMMMMMM.</p>
 <p>With each gong, he floats up a level</p>	<p>Gong. Gong. Gong.</p>
 <p>Up another level. He reaches the top of the screen, where you can just see the bottom of his feet.</p>	<p>Gong.</p>
<p>The gong stops. Without the gong he falls. His arms and legs go out flailing hitting and knocking over the gong.</p> <p>His facial expression is severe fear and anxiety.</p> <p>He crashes into the purple pillow, crawls over to the gong, put it back up. He goes back to the pillow places himself into lotus and goes completely serene again.</p>	<p>NO GONG.</p> <p>Gong crashes.</p> <p>Soft crash into pillow.</p> <p>Clang of gong going back into place.</p> <p>Gong!</p>
